Maiden Hunter: Open to horses and ponies in their first year of showing over 2' or higher. No restrictions on riders.

Low/Schooling Hunter: Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Low Hunter to jump 2', Schooling Hunter to jump 2'6".

- 5. Low/Schooling Hunter-Over Fences (2', 2'6")
- 6. Low/Schooling Hunter-Under Saddle

7. VHSA/BHSA Child/Adult Eq. Fences 2'6" or 3'

Children's/Adult Hunter: Open to juniors or adult amateurs on horses. Fences 2'6" or 3'.

Green Hunter: Open to horses in their first or second year of showing at 2'6".

Pleasure Horse: Open to horses ridden by juniors or adults. Judge on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners and suitability.

- *+21. Junior/Adult Pleasure Horse-Walk Trot
- *+22. Junior/Adult Pleasure Horse-GAYP
- *+23. Junior/Adult Pleasure Horse-Under Saddle

Schooling/Lunch Break Not before Noon

Pleasure Pony: Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners & suitability.

- *+24. Pleasure Pony-Walk/Trot
- *+25. Pleasure Pony-Go As You Please
- *+26. Pleasure Pony-Walk/Trot/Canter

Pony Equitation: Open to ponies ridden by juniors. At least 1/4 of class to return for the flat.

*+27. VHSA/BHSA Associate Pony Equitation

Small (2') Medium (2'3") Large (2'6")

Pony Hunter: Open to ponies not exceeding 14.2 hands, ridden by juniors.

- *+28. Pony Hunter-Over Fences (2', 2'3", 2'6")
- *+29. Pony Hunter-Over Fences (2', 2'3", 2'6")
- *+30. Pony Hunter-Under Saddle

Leadline: Open to riders 7 years of age and under as of Dec $\mathbf{1}^{st}$ of current show year.

Riders not allowed to cross enter into any class where they would be asked to trot.

+31. Leadline-50% Rider, 50% Pony (BHSA)

10 Minute Schooling Break for Pre Short & Short Stirrup

Pre Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 10 &

under, may only cross enter any class that canters or jumps.

- +32. Pre Short Stirrup Eq.- Walk
- +33. Pre Short Stirrup Eq. -Walk/Trot
- +34. Pre Short Stirrup Eq. -Walk/Trot/Obstacles

Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders 12 years of age & under. Riders not allowed to cross enter into classes where they would jump over 18".

- +35. Short Stirrup Eq. Walk/Trot
- +36. Short Stirrup Eq. Walk/Trot/Canter
- +37. Short Stirrup Eq Over Fences (18")

Short Stirrup Hunter: Open to rider 12 years of age & under. May not cross enter into another VHSA Division, except pleasure & eq flat.

- *38. Short Stirrup Hunter-O/F
- *39. Short Stirrup Hunter-O/F
- *40. Short Stirrup Hunter-U/S

Rules

There will be six ribbons in each class. Champion & Reserve Ribbons & Prizes.

The Judges Decision is final.

Points awarded per Associate Rules.

Approved Hats required when mounted.

The show manager has the right to split, combine or cancel any division if there are sufficient entries.

A negative coggins within 12 months must be presented in order to show. Please bring a copy.

All dogs must be on a leash.

A \$35 fee will be charged for all returned checks.
All classes are governed by the rules/specifications set by the VHSA/BHSA rule books. The Orange County Fair any officials, employees, or board of directors, will not be held responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, spectator, groom, or animal on the show grounds.
